## Project Notes

---

*Master Bath in the Andersen residence, San Jose, California* - The project involved enlarging the existing small master bath by removing an adjusting closet, putting in a pocket door instead of a standard swing door, and completely reconfiguring the floor plan. A small acrylic shower enclosure was replaced by a two-person custom tiled shower and a bench with a solid quartz surface.

Lost closet storage was generously

compensated for by a floor-to-ceiling linen cabinet, double vanities and wall counter tower. Drawer space was doubled. An outdated tiled countertop gave way to a seamless quartz surface; non-porous and impervious to heat. Larger size porcelain tile was used in the shower and on the floor, combined with multi-color glass mosaic. Safety grab bars were installed in the shower. The new toilet was comfort height and featured the water-saving G-Max mechanism and soft-closing seat.
